The 2012 IUPUI Field School is for six weeks (May 9 - June 20) at the Angel Mounds State Historic Site in Evansville, Indiana. The Angel Site (12Vg1), a National Landmark, is a large prehistoric Mississippian town (A.D. 1100-1450) with 11 earthen mounds and a palisade. Students will be trained in archaeological excavation methods and theory, and learn to identify Mississippian pottery, tools and other elements of material culture. Instruction will also be given on equipment now commonly used in archaeological investigations, such as mapping, surveying, and geophysical instruments, and in pedology and geoarchaeology techniques.
